2. W: WORD

Word refers to the scripture you are studying! Select your activity based on the details below.

- Kindergarten- 1 grade have them simply write out the scripture reference. Have them recite the verse or sing the song as someone helps them write the verse.
- Everyone else write out the scripture you are studying. This will help with focus and memorization.



3. M: MEANING:

What is the meaning of the passage in the Bible? Too many people use scripture to mean what they want it to rather than in context. Remember scripture never contradicts other scripture but supports it. To make sure you have an accurate meaning of the text look up other scriptures if possible on the subject (ex. lying, look up several scriptures on lying and compare them to each other.)

- 🏂 Kindergarten- 1st grade- Can draw a picture or use stickers to help with theirs.
- Younger children will not write as much but can retell what they have read in their own words.
- Everyone else try to think deeper about the meaning. Try and imaging how this verse relates to your life



4. E: EVERYDAY:

It is great to know what the Bible means and where it is found but what does it mean to me today? When I go to work, school, or hangout with friends (online or in person) what then is the meaning of the God's Word? Write down how the scripture applies to everyday life.



5. 3: 3 WAYS TO PRACTICE:

Now that you know the scripture, the meaning, and how it applies to everyday life, what are you going to do with it? James 1:22 says, "Do not merely listen to the word and so deceive yourself. Do what it says." Think through 3 simple ways to practice what you have learned from God's Word. Then work it into your everyday life by putting it into practice to Turn Your World Around. Think of 3 people you can share what you learned with and invite them to memorize with you.
